



## *1 Sep – 7 Sep*

Monday  
1 Sep

- Ezekiel 24:1-27;
- Jeremiah 52:3-5;
- Jeremiah 39:1;
- II Kings 25:1, 2;
- Jeremiah 52:29;
- Jeremaih 32:1-5;
- Jeremiah 34:8-22

Most of today's reading is about the fall of Jerusalem to the Babylonians—which would be very soon. But note in Ezekiel 24:15-18 that God told Ezekiel of the fact that his wife would soon die, and that he was forbidden to mourn. These events were during the reign of Zedekiah.

Tuesday  
2 Sep

- Ezekiel 29:1-16;
- Ezekiel 26:1 to 28:19

The first prophecy is against Egypt several years 2 before its fall. Chapters 26-28 are against Tyre, the seacoast city northwest of Judah. (Note that we read Ezekiel 28:11-19 on Week One, Day 2).

Wednesday  
3 Sep

- Ezekiel 30:20-26;
- Ezekiel 31:1-18;
- Jeremiah 37:3-21;
- Jeremiah 32:6-44

This reading begins with more prophecies against Pharaoh and Egypt. Then we have the stories of Jeremiah's imprisonment and his buying a field as a sign that the people would be able to return to the land after their punishment at the hand of God.

Thursday  
4 Sep

- Jeremiah 33:1-26;
- Jeremiah 34:1-7;
- Jeremiah 38:1-27;
- Jeremiah 39:15-18

Now we read about God's promise for the future of His people (chapter 33), the certainty of the destruction (chapter 34), Jeremiah in the dungeon and before Zedekiah (chapter 38), and his prophecy to an Ethiopian (chapter 39).

Friday  
5 Sep

Finally, and tragically, we come to the fall of Jerusalem (586 BC). (Note that II Kings 25, Jeremiah 39 and 52, and II Chronicles 36 supplement one another on the story of the fall).

Here is more of the inspired account of the desolation of Jerusalem.

Psalm 74 is a plea for God not to cast them off forever.

Psalm 79 is similar, with a plea for forgiveness.

- Lamentations 1:1-22

Lamentations begins Jeremiah's poetic description of the grief over the fall of Jerusalem.

Sunday  
7 Sep

- Lamentations 2:1 to 5:22

Jeremiah continues to mourn over the fallen city and pleads for God's mercy.
